

BSides Bucharest Security Conference 2018

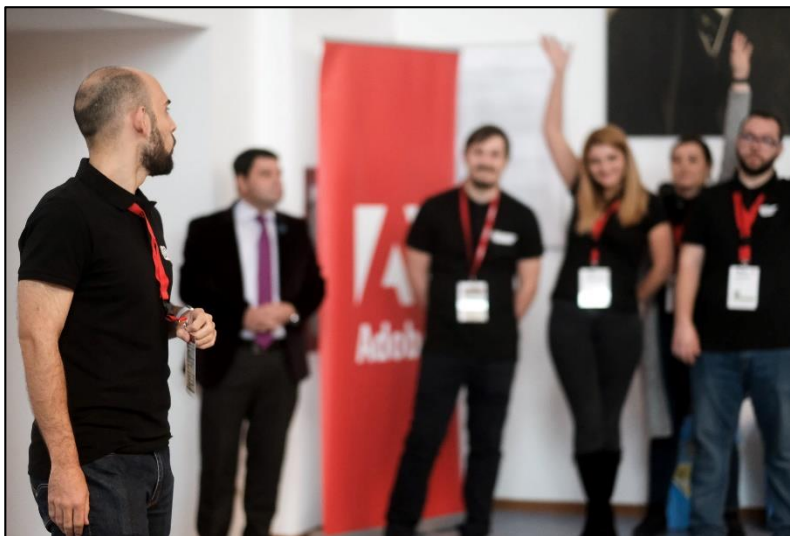
